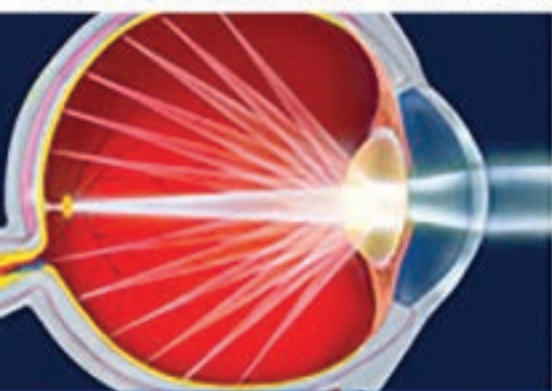


CATARACT **& MY VISION** **AFTER CATARACT SURGERY**



Cataract & Cataract Surgery

Cataract surgery is a procedure to remove the clouded lens of your eye and, in most cases, replace it with an artificial lens.

Why

should I get my eyes checked after surgery?

The natural lens inside the eye become cloudy due to cataract formation. This cloudy lens is removed and replaced with an artificial lens which is called Intra Ocular Lens (IOL) to restore vision in cataract surgery.

Mostly monofocal IOL's are used and improve distance vision after the surgery more than existed. As well as reading glasses need to use for near tasks such as reading and sewing, since your present spectacle prescription is changing after the surgery due to vision improvement.

It is recommended to wear a Quality Sunglass after the surgery to protect your eyes from UV rays and from the sun during day time.
